RULES OF PARTICIPATION

Teams must be available to work on site at least one day from April 22-24. We encourage you to work all three days if possible. The salvage yard will be open to teams from 9am-5pm each day for teams to work. All main parts for your piece of artwork must be pulled by 12noon on Saturday. Teams MUST be on site from 9am-5pm on Sunday, April 25 to work, have their piece of artwork judged, and clean up their workspace. Judging will be done by a team of judges at 3pm on Sunday.

You may take your artwork to your workshop/studio after the event to do last minute work, but it must be returned to the Arts Council of Wayne County by June 25. If the works are not returned you will be billed for the average sales price of the pieces of artwork! All pieces must be for sale through the ACWC. The ACWC will retain a minimum 60% commission from sales of sculptures. There are no specific requirements for the sculptures as far as style, content, etc. but remember these pieces will go on display to the general public, including children, so please keep this in mind when creating your artwork. All artwork must be able to fit through the 55" x 90" double doors at the Arts Council. They MUST be able to be moved from the salvage yard to the ACWC and MUST be freestanding.

All team members must be over the age of 18. Teams may have 2-4 members, requests for solo entries or larger teams will be considered on a case by case basis. Teams must provide their own welding equipment, though there may be an option to rent or borrow equipment if needed. A generator will be available for use by the teams. Overnight secure storage will be available on site for your equipment. Teams must provide their own safety equipment and adhere to standard work safety practices throughout their participation in this event.

There is no cost to enter and all materials (other than welding materials) will be donated by Wayne Auto Salvage and Bevell's Pull It Yourself Used Auto Parts. There will be approximately 1200 cars available to pull parts from for this event. You may not take parts away from the salvage yard and you may not bring in your own parts without prior approval.
