INFORMATION AND AGREEMENT

The Caldwell Arts Council is hosting a Hometown Handmade Holiday Market weekends during December. We are excited to showcase local food, art and craft vendors. Please complete the form below to participate. Also feel free to tell any other craft/local good producers you feel may want to participate. (Please note the Caldwell Arts Council is a juried gallery. We encourage and promote the high quality Fine Art and Artisan Crafts, which are original creations of the artist and professional in appearance. All works must be in compliance with copyright law. Vendors must submit their applications by November 30th to be juried for the Hometown Handmade Holiday Market, if you have not participated in the Satie's Gift Shop or Satie's Holiday Sale in the past.)

Vendor Spaces:

Space sizes vary (but all will accommodate at least a 6-foot table, and all include wall space). All spaces are \$35/weekend. Vendors provide their own tables, chairs, cloths, displays, hanging supplies, etc. Vendor spaces will be filled on the main floor first, with additional vendor spaces available in our upstairs gallery. Up to 3 artists may go in together on any space.

Electricity:

An electrical outlet is available in each space, if desired. Bring a 3-to-2 prong adapter (it's an old building...) and your own strip plug(s) and cord(s).

Music:

Music will be provided throughout the space.

Vendor Responsibility & Indemnification:

Vendors will be fully responsible for any loss or damage to his or her property by theft, fire or casualty. The Caldwell Arts Council expressly disclaims any responsibility for same. Vendors shall be responsible for any damage which may be incurred to the facilities as a result of or in connection with its operation. Each vendor is responsible for the conduct of its employees/representatives, and activities must not detract from the image or welfare of the Caldwell Arts Council. Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Caldwell Arts Council from and against any loss, expense, claims, damages, causes of action, injuries, suits or damages, suits to person or property, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to the operation of the event.

Direct Sales and Staffing:

This is not a consignment sale; vendors will be responsible for manning their tables/booths at all times and intact until the market closes each day. The Caldwell Arts Council is not responsible for merchandise or display materials. Money collected by on-site vendors, along with any sales taxes, are the responsibility of the vendor. Guest internet access is available to vendors for using PayPal, Square, or any other third-party payment process.

Setup / Breakdown:

All vendors may begin setting up Thursday afternoon (2-5pm) or Friday morning (9am-12noon) and must be ready to sell by 12:00 NOON Friday and by 10:00 AM Saturday during the event. Break down can start no sooner than 4:00 PM Saturday, to be completed by 6:00 PM. No sales items may be left

until the following weekend (your tables/displays may remain in place if you have reserved additional weekends). Vendors are responsible for keeping their space clean and trash-free.

Vendor Items:

Each vendor must be juried in by November 30th *if you have not previously been juried in for either the Satie's Gift Shop or Satie's Holiday Sale in the past.* The Caldwell Arts Council reserves the right to have items removed that are considered not appropriate.

Cancellation of space:

Vendor fees are non-refundable; if you are unable to participate for some reason, we will give you a donation acknowledgment for tax purposes.

Satie's Gift Shop Consignment:

Works currently held on consignment in the Caldwell Arts Council's Satie's Gift Shop may not be sold without a gallery commission during the Handmade Hometown Holiday Market. Current consignment artists wishing to set up as vendors for this event may pull consignment works from the gift shop inventory prior to the event, if desired. Otherwise, current consignment artists are expected to honor their consignment agreements with works already listed in the consignment system. Additional consignment items may be sought for this event. Consignment purchases will be made in the office with Caldwell Arts Council staff.
